

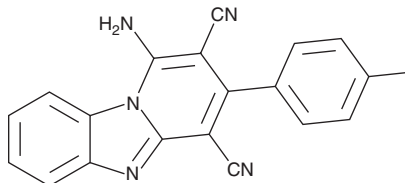

Laboratory Procedures

iFSP1 is supplied as a crystalline solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the iFSP1 in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. iFSP1 is soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide (DMF). The solubility of iFSP1 in these solvents is approximately 1, 25, and 30 mg/ml, respectively.

iFSP1 is sparingly soluble in aqueous buffers. For maximum solubility in aqueous buffers, iFSP1 should first be dissolved in DMF and then diluted with the aqueous buffer of choice. iFSP1 has a solubility of approximately 0.1 mg/ml in a 1:7 solution of DMF:PBS (pH 7.2) using this method. We do not recommend storing the aqueous solution for more than one day.

Description

iFSP1 is an inhibitor of apoptosis inducing factor mitochondria-associated 2/ferroptosis suppressor protein 1 (AIFM2/FSP1).¹ It decreases cell viability in glutathione peroxidase 4 (GPX4) knockout, but not wild-type, Pfa1 and HT1080 cells overexpressing AIFM2/FSP1, an effect that can be blocked by the ferroptosis inhibitor liproxstatin-1 (Item No. 17730). iFSP1 (3 μM) sensitizes a variety of human cancer cell lines to the ferroptosis inducer (1S,3R)-RSL3 (Item No. 19288).
