

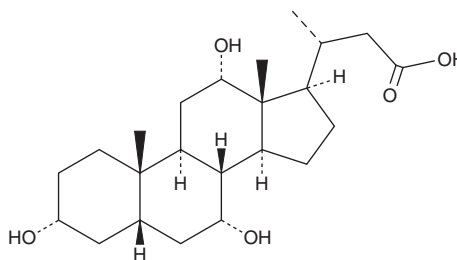

Laboratory Procedures

Norcholeic acid is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the norcholeic acid in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Norcholeic acid is slightly soluble in methanol and DMSO.

Description

Norcholeic acid is a bile acid and 23-carbon derivative of cholic acid (Item No. 20250).¹ Levels of norcholeic acid are increased in the urine of patients with liver cirrhosis or cerebrotendinous xanthomatosis (CTX), an inborn error of metabolism characterized by a deficiency in the mitochondrial enzyme sterol 27-hydroxylase (CYP27A1) that leads to progressive neurological symptoms.²⁻⁴
